Thousands of people in southeast Michigan are left homeless every year. Homelessness has many causes: mental illness, addiction, financial emergency, a home fire, job loss, or landlords not paying their mortgage.

Homeless people might have very few belongings and often times do not even have a blanket to stay warm during Michigan's frigid winters. They may also lack the basic hygiene items needed to clean up, such as soap, washcloth, towel, deodorant, or comb.

Through its local blanket and hygiene kit program, World Medical Relief provides new twin-size and crib blankets as well as hygiene kits.



Frequently Asked Questions

When do collections take place?

World Medical Relief invites schools, churches, retirement communities, and individual supporters to participate in this local relief effort in early fall. Blanket collections take place in September and October. Monetary donations for this program are accepted year round.

When are donations distributed?

In early November, new crib and twin-size blankets are distributed to homeless shelters and other human service agencies that are helping the homeless and the very poor in Metro Detroit.

The same agencies request thousands of hygiene kits from World Medical Relief for distribution to their clients.

What is a hygiene kit?

Hygiene kits are small bundles containing a washcloth, towel, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, and deodorant. Supporters of the program donate money. World Medical Relief orders the kit materials in bulk and volunteers assemble the kits.

What is a crib blanket?

A special blanket for infants and toddlers.
