Local Supply Services:

- Prescription Medications
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Medical Supplies
- Adult Diapers/Bed Pads
- Ostomy Supplies

Clients can also receive durable medical equipment such as a wheelchair, walker, bath chair, or hospital bed, etc. A small handling fee will be charged. We require a referral from a health care worker or a prescription from your physician. Call first to check on availability.

We have adult briefs, pull-ups and bed pads available by the case. Call for prices if you are interested.

Basic dressings, ostomy supplies and liquid nutrition can be purchased based upon availability at a nominal charge. A referral is needed for these items.

All of the items discussed above must be picked up and paid for by cash, money order or credit card.

Who Qualifies?

People are eligible if:

- They are 18 years or older
- Earn \$21,780* or less per year (individual)
- Earn \$29,420* or less per year for a couple. (Add \$300 per dependent.)
- No prescription drug coverage
- Not enrolled in Medicaid

Over 1.3 million drugs have been dispensed with this program.



Frequently Asked Questions

Where do I have to live to qualify?

In the state of Michigan.

I am not a U.S. citizen. Do I qualify?

Yes, if you qualify for the income criteria.

What drugs are available?

Many commonly used drugs are available which include brand names and generics.

How much does it cost?

\$8.30 per prescription.

How many days can I order at the time?

A 30 day supply.

How long does it take to get my medication?

Once approved you will receive your first medicine(s) between 3-5 days.

I have Medicare Part D. Do I qualify?

You may qualify. Please contact WMR at 313-866-5333 to discuss.

What does my doctor have to do?

Your doctor needs to call the prescription in to World Medical Relief (313) 866-5333 or fax it to (313) 866-5588.

I have no income. Do I qualify?

Yes, you must come in person and bring the prescription and paperwork. When you pick your order up, pay with cash or a money order.
